TVs (incl. consoles): \$10 fee	microwave ovens, toasters	vacuum and carpet cleaners
Monitors with CRT: \$2 fee (waived if with a computer)	laptop computers, printers, servers, mouses, keyboards	home phones (corded & cordless), and cell phones
copiers, faxes, cables, motors	VCR/DVD players, cables	UPS back-up batteries, etc.
