Traffic Slowdown

ADOT will begin a project to rehabilitate both pavement and bridges on I-19 between Canoa Ranch Road and Duval Mine Road. Work is scheduled to begin on **Tuesday, Jan. 16**. ADOT advises motorists to plan for the following restrictions and expect delays of up to 10 minutes:

- Northbound and southbound I-19 will be reduced to one lane (right lane closed) at various locations between Esperanza Boulevard and Canoa Ranch Road from 6:30 AM, Tuesday, Jan. 16, to 5 PM, Friday, Jan. 19, daily.
- Speed will be reduced from 65 to 45 mph.
