Motorists on Interstate 19 near Green Valley should expect alternating lane closures **starting Monday, June 17**.

Crews will install final striping on the roadway between Duval Mine Road and the Canoa Ranch Rest Area between **6 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday**. The work is expected to take about one week. In addition, crews will place striping on Esperanza Boulevard near the I-19 interchange. All interstate ramps will remain open during the work.
